**UCO ELECTIONS-** On 3/1, UCO Delegates will elect a new President, a Treasurer, two Vice Presidents, two Secretaries, and ten Executive Board Members. All UCO Delegates should represent their Associations by voting. It is not necessary for Delegates to attend the monthly Delegate Assembly meeting to vote, but voting must be done in person at the CV Clubhouse, starting at 8:00 AM and ending at 9:30 AM. Only registered UCO Delegates or Alternate Delegates may vote. CV Association Boards that wish to update their UCO Delegates lists must do so by 12:00 PM on Wednesday, 2/28. A list of candidates, with pictures, is appended to this report.

**PAINTING, EASTHAMPTON SECTION-** On 2/22 and 2/23, two sections of masonry wall near Easthampton C were pressure cleaned and painted by Pergolizzi Painting. These walls are near perimeter fencing, so Budget Gate and Fence removed sections of fence to give the painter room to work. When the painting was finished, the fence sections were put back up.

**REFLECTION BAY-** On 2/22, the PBC Board of County Commissioners approved a plan for a Community Development District to be established at the former CV golf course. This special taxation district will allow Reflection Bay to build out necessary infrastructure (water, sewers, drainage, roads, etc.), and will have no financial (tax) impact on CV unit owners.

**TREE BRUSH CLEARING, SOUTHAMPTON SECTION-** Last week, Curtis Landscaping completed brush and tree clearing at the eastern end of Southampton section. Now, our green fence will be repaired and reinforced, the CV side of the masonry wall will be pressure cleaned and painted, and additional cameras will be installed along the fence line.

COVENTRY SECTION- THIS NEW SCREEN, AT THE IRRIGATION PUMP WELL-HEAD, WAS INSTALLED BY CHABOT IRRIGATION LAST WEEK. THERE ARE ONLY TWO IRRIGATION PUMP STATIONS IN CV THAT OPERATE FROM WELLS. THE OTHER 25 PUMP STATIONS DRAW WATER FROM CV WATERWAYS.



COVENTRY SECTION- THIS NEW FILTER WAS INSTALLED BY CHABOT IRRIGATION LAST WEEK; IT KEEPS MINERAL DEPOSITS OUT OF THE PUMP AND REDUCES WEAR ON THE PUMP MOTOR. THIS THING NEEDS TO BE CLEANED OUT PERIODICALLY.



COVENTRY D- JET SKIS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE PARKED AT CV ASSOCIATION PARKING AREAS. A COMPLAINT HAS BEEN SENT TO PBC CODE ENFORCEMENT. USE OF GUEST PARKING FOR UNIT OWNER "TOYS" IS ALSO A CODE VIOLATION. GUEST PARKING IS FOR GUESTS.



PLYMOUTH POOL- THIS POOL IS NOW OPEN AND HAS A NICE NEW AWNING AS WELL.
