## 6/24/2024 PROPERTY MANAGER'S REPORT By Donald Foster, LCAM

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**MAINS OFF GENERATOR TEST-** On **6/21**, in preparation for hurricane season, T.S.I. Electric performed a "mains off" test of the emergency generator at the UCO Office. This test involved cutting off electric power to the building, observing the emergency generator automatic startup, and allowing the building to run on generator power for fifteen minutes.

**STREETLIGHTS-** On **6/20**, FPL repaired a number of dark street lights on North Drive and West Drive.

TREE REMOVALS- On 6/21, Curtis Landscaping removed a dead tree from the north side of South Drive, and a tree along Okeechobee Boulevard that was causing damage to a perimeter fence. A magnolia tree will be planted on South Drive to replace the dead tree. At the request of the Somerset J Board, W.P.R.F removed a sea grape tree that was growing near the waterline of Lake Somerset.

**EXCURSION BUS-** On **Friday**, **7/12**, UCO will provide an excursion bus trip to the **Palm Beach County Solid Waste Authority** facility on Jog Road. In-person sign up for this trip will happen on **Tuesday**, **7/2** and **Wednesday**, **7/3**, **9:30** to **10:30 AM**, at the **CV Clubhouse Lobby**. Participation for this trip will be limited to 25 CV residents.

UNAUTHORIZED DEMOLITION/CONSTRUCTION, UPDATE- Last week, I reported on another instance of interior walls destroyed and construction happening at an **Greenbrier B unit**, without the knowledge of or permission from the Board. Many of these unauthorized demos are being done by a particular unlicensed contractor, **PAULO DIAS**. I directed our security contractor to prevent Dias from entering CV. I sent a complaint to the PBC Construction Industry Licensing Board, Contractor Certification Division. The matter is under investigation.

UNPERMITTED DEMOLITION, BEDFORD D- On 6/17, I received a report that unlicensed contractor DIAS had renovated 96 BEDFORD D. Interior walls were removed without prior permission from the Board and without engineering. Plumbing and electrical work was performed without subpermits, and the master permit was pulled by a different licenced contractor, DIOGENES DIPRE. I sent reports to PBC Code Enforcement and the PBC Board of Contractor. The matter is under investigation.

UNPERMITTED DEMOLITION, 118 SOMERSET F- On 6/18, a Somerset F Director reported demo activity happening at 118 SOMERSET F. Security Director Zelaya investigated, and found workers removing interior walls, kitchen/bathroom cabinets, and plumbing fixtures. When I checked the PZB permit tracking website, there were no permits on file. At the request of the Somerset F Director, I ordered all work to stop, and sent a report to PBC Code Enforcement. This Association Board will need to formally authorize any demolition or construction work at this unit, after consulting with their Attorney. The Board must also confirm that building permits are issued, and that any contractors working in the unit are properly licensed and insured.

UNPERMITTED DEMOLITION, 196 ANDOVER H- On 6/20, I received a report of unpermitted demolition at 196 ANDOVER H. I found that interior walls have been removed without prior knowledge of or permission from the Board. There are no permits on file. At the Board's direction, I ordered all work to stop, and sent a report to PBC Code Enforcement.

**UNPERMITTED DEMOLITION, 481 WELLINGTON K-** On, **6/21**, I received a report of unpermitted demolition at **481 WELLINGTON K.** I inspected this unit, and found that interior walls have been removed without prior knowledge of or permission by the Board. There are no permits on file. At the Board's direction, I ordered all work to stop and advised the Board to consult with their Property Manager and Attorney before allowing work to resume. I reported the unpermitted demo work to PBC Code Enforcement.


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
